Students who take the B2 level Pancyprian Examinations: LISTENING

- 3. can understand the majority of films in standard dialect.

READING

- 4. can read articles and reports concerned with contemporary problems in which the writers adopt particular stances or viewpoints.
- 5. can read with a large degree of independence, different texts and purposes.
- 6. can scan through long and complex texts, locating relevant details.
- 7. can identify the content and relevance of news items, articles and reports on a wide range of professional topics.

WRITING

- 8. can write emails or letters highlighting the personal significance of events and experiences.
- 9. can write clear, detailed descriptions/texts on a wide range of subjects related to their field of interest.
- 10. can write a report passing on information.
- 11. can write clear, detailed texts on a variety of subjects related to their field of interest, synthesising and evaluating information and arguments.
- 12. can explain a viewpoint on a topical issue giving the advantages and disadvantages of various options.
- 13. can write an essay in support of or against a particular point of view
- 14. can evaluate different ideas or solutions to a problem
